2. Project Result:

The developed performance was delivered in the presence of Bulgarian and Romanian publics and broadcasted on Bulgarian and Romanian TVs. The established a Bulgarian-Romanian Cultural Informational Center is more one key project result too. Through the established Center the project initiated cultural cooperation and development of a cultural informational network with the participation of different local cultural organizations in the border region. Other project result is the developed study for available Romanian and Bulgarian cultural products and institutions. Expect this it was published 1000 catalogues, promoting cultural diversity of Bulgaria and Romania and was recorded 500 DVDs with the developed performance and 500 CDs with the music of the performance. One more successfully project result is the developed web-page which promotes the cultural diversity of Romania and Bulgaria. In the end of the project implementation was approved three new common project proposals, which are potential for future common projects.

The project is a sustainable development of a past implemented project between Montana-tomorrow Foundation and PLIMM, Calafat.
