





DECISION no. 52 of June 14th, 2011

Approving the method for using the reserve lists

Having regard to the following:

- The articles 63 and 65 of Council Regulation no. 1083/2006 laying down general provisions on the European Regional Development Fund, the European Social Fund and the Cohesion Fund and repealing Regulation (EC) no. 1260/1999,
- the section 6.1.4 of Romania-Bulgaria Cross-Border Cooperation Programme 2007-2013,
- the article 2 and article 9 from the Rules of Procedure of the Joint Monitoring Committee for Romania-Bulgaria Cross-Border Cooperation Programme 2007-2013, the Joint Monitoring Committee of the Romania-Bulgaria Cross-Border Cooperation Programme 2007-2013 has adopted this:

DECISION

- **Article 1** The present document approves the method for using the reserve lists in the context of the second call for regular projects according to which contracting the projects will be done for each priority axis in chronological order and according to the scores obtained (first the reserve list for the respective priority axis for July projects and than the list for October projects).
- **Article 2** The reserve list at the date of the present decision is presented in Annex 1 and will be updated after each JSC decision regarding project evaluation in the context of the second call for regular projects.
- Article 3 Every 2 (two) months starting with (and including) the month of the JMC approval, the JTS will ask the LP of projects included in the reserve lists whether they maintain their projects on the reserve list or give up financing for the respective project. In case of redraws, both JMC and JSC will be informed accordingly.
- Article 4 Every 2 (two) months starting with (and including) the month of the JMC approval, the JTS will ask the LP of the first project from the reserve list for each priority axis whether it accepts the project to be financed only with the amount available at that moment for the respective priority axis and finance from own ressources the rest of the approved budget. The LP will have a deadline of maximum 10 working days to provide an answer. In case of 2 (two) consecutive negative answers, the MA/NA may propose to the JMC the exclusion of the respective project from the reserve list.

Annex 5 - The JMC will be informed by the Permanent Secretariat of any modification to the reserve list.

Article 6 - In case of decommitment at Programme level, any amount available at the moment of decommitment can be used to this end, observing all other provisions from the legislation in force.
