

**DECISION no. 64
of 08.06.2012**

Modifying the Decision no. 52 for approving the method for using the reserve lists

Having regard to the following:

- The articles 63 and 65 of Council Regulation no. 1083/2006 laying down general provisions on the European Regional Development Fund, the European Social Fund and the Cohesion Fund and repealing Regulation (EC) no. 1260/1999,
- the section 6.1.4 of Romania-Bulgaria Cross-Border Cooperation Programme 2007-2013,
- the article 2 and article 9 from the Rules of Procedure of the Joint Monitoring Committee for Romania-Bulgaria Cross-Border Cooperation Programme 2007-2013, the Joint Monitoring Committee of the Romania-Bulgaria Cross-Border Cooperation Programme 2007-2013 has adopted this:

DECISION

Article 1- JTS will submit the financial allocation available according to MA Instruction No. 43/02.12.2011 to MA/NA whenever financial allocation, as described in art.2, becomes available for the projects under reserve list.

Article 2- After MA / NA approval of the financial allocation available, projects that are placed first on the reserve list, for each of the priority axis 1, 2 or 3, will be notified in writing by the JTS according to the following methodology:

The LP of the project will be notified by the JTS on the amounts available on Programme level and the amount that the project partners should cover from own resources, *only if the amounts available on Programme level for the respective priority axis represents at least 90% of the total approved eligible budget*. LP will have a deadline of maximum 10 days to provide an answer.

Step 1:

Case 1: In case of an acceptance of the project partners to finance the difference up to 100%, JTS will start the contracting procedure.

Case 2: If no response or a negative response is received, the project will be asked again after 3 months.

Step 2 (after 3 months):

Case 1: In case of an acceptance of the project to finance the difference up to 100%, JTS will start the contracting procedure.

Case 2: If no response or a second negative response is received the project **will be rejected from funding** and the next project on the reserve list will be asked after the same methodology.

Article 3- Projects on the reserve list for which the approved implementation period is greater than the period between the approval date of the situation of available allocation and 31/12/2015 and which cannot implement their activities until 31.12.2015, will be removed from the reserve list. In case a shorter period of implementation will be assumed by the beneficiary, the proposal will be subject to JSC approval.

Article 4- The JMC and the JSC will be informed by the Permanent Secretariat of any modification of the reserve list.

Article 5- In case of decommitment at Programme level, any amount available at the moment of decommitment can be used to this end, observing all other provisions from the legislation in force.
